What are Cookies?

Cookies are little text files which are stored on the browser or hard drive of your computer or mobile device when you visit a webpage or application. Our server calls on those cookies when you visit our website.

There are different types of cookies. Some cookies come directly from our website and others come from third parties which place cookies on our site.

Cookies can be stored for varying lengths of time on your browser or device. Session cookies are deleted from your computer or device when you close your web-browser. Persistent cookies will remain stored on your computer or device until deleted or until they reach their expiry date.

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** These are cookies which are required for the operation of our website.
- **Analytical/performance cookies:** These cookies tell us about how you use the site and they help us to make it better. For example, these cookies count the number of visitors to our website and see how visitors move around when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our site works, for example, by ensuring that users find what they are looking for easily.

How do we use Cookies?

The following table sets out details of the cookies used on our website, including what they are used for and for how long the cookies are used (the 'expiry time'):

Cookie Name	Type	Purpose and description	Expiry Time
_ga	Analytical	Used by Google Analytics to distinguish users on the website. These cookies collect information in a way that does not directly identify anyone.	2 Years
ga<container-id>	Analytical	Used to store and count page views on the website. These cookies collect information in a way that does not directly identify anyone.	2 Years



How do you change Cookie preferences or block Cookies?

To opt-out or block the use of any cookies (other than 'strictly necessary' cookies) you can click the 'Reject' button on the popup at the bottom of the page which appears when you enter our site for the first time.

You can also choose whether you wish to accept cookies or not, by using the appropriate settings for your browser. Different browsers make different controls available to you. Generally, your browser will offer you the choice to accept, refuse or delete cookies at all times, or those from certain providers, or those from specific websites. Each browser's website should contain instructions on how you can do this.
